Intermediate:

Diving class is for the diver who wants to learn more diving skills than lessons, but has limited time to train. Intermediate diving introduces your diver to competitive diving, allowing them to discover diving as their sport of choice.

Pre-Team

Designed for divers to compete Novice level in the sport of diving. Divers will progress at this level preparing for the team level.

Olympic Garden (7-11 years old)

This group is designed for young talent to have World Class potential in the sport of diving. This is a developmental program not based on early competition. This is a feeding program for our elite training program.

Team:

Divers can choose what level they would like to train based on committed days to train. 1-3 day divers will focus on US diving program & AAU diving program. This level is committed to help divers receive athletic scholarships for the university level.

Elite

Focus on National Champion & International level divers. Diver must be a finalist in US National or identified as a future medalist. Must have alternative education plan. Example- Home School or on-line High School program.

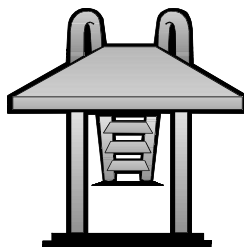

Payment requirements

There are no refunds of any kind.

Amy Kwan:

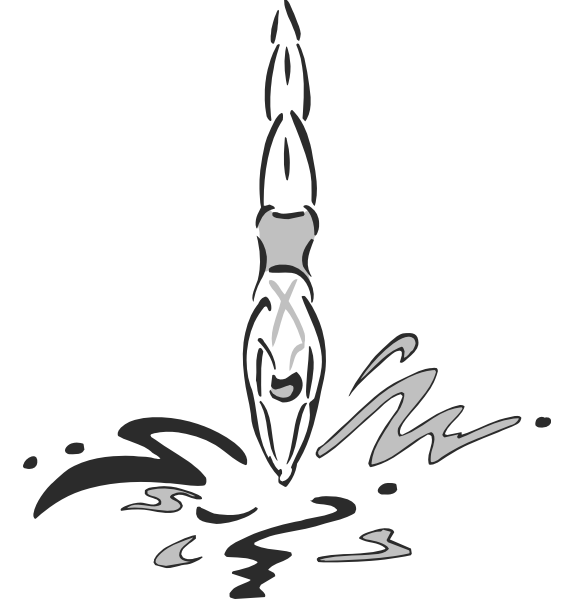
